Secretary Report

Moved VK3GNB / VK3BVI - carried

Treasurers Report

Acting Treasurer Gordon VK3FGC thanked the club and committee for granting him life membership, this had come as a complete surprise to him.

Gordon also tabled a proposed budget for the 08/09 year.

Moved Gordon VK3FGC / VK3ADE report and budget be accepted – carried

Gordon also moved a motion "That the audited accounts for the financial year ending 30 June 2008 be received and accepted, together with the auditors report, and that the required numbers of copies of the accounts be sent to the appropriate Victorian Government departments". Seconded VK3BVI – carried

Other Reports

Radio Modernisation – David VK3BUR

Dipole was fixed at Saturday morning working bee, problem was a bad coupler, computer interface For antenna controller almost completed, no news on grant application as yet, awaiting opportunity to complete antenna work at Mount Buninyong – to be done in conjunction with work by other users of site.

Repeaters – Roger VK3ADE

Ben Nevis still suffering from noise problem, there is also a design problem at this site, if the computer link fails, it fails the repeater as well.

Mt William 2 metre repeater apparently has a broken antenna and faulty finals, there is a new 70cm repeater coming soon, and antenna work will be carried out shortly. Application for community services grant is in progress (projector?)

Convention – Roger VK3ADE, Ian VK3AXH

55 tables have been booked, catering arrangements have been confirmed, cash register has been arranged, may need to get some extra trestles, ICOM will be doing D-STAR presentation in a separate area, we will need to set up chairs, we will need plenty of helpers early on the morning of convention.

Education – Craig VK3CMC

2 Candidates for assessment only on 19th October – 1 for upgrade, 1 for F Call, 2 members will be travelling to Geelong for assessment training, this will help to reduce the workload of the existing assessors. Another foundation training course could be arranged for late November or early December if there is sufficient interest.

Construction – Brian VK3KQB

Some members are working on projects at home, Brian has a mystery project planned for next construction night, components supplied, bring a soldering iron if you can.

Amenities – Doug VK3VBA is going to continue doing the shopping for suppers etc. Bob VK3NBV will be the cook.

General Business – Doug VK3VBA has purchased a SD card for club members to used to record / store photos of club events, photos will need to be downloaded to computer, Charlie VK3DCS offered to donate an internal card reader for the computer if someone could fit it, Craig VK3CMC suggested that we should have more, and more recent photos on the website.

Christmas break-up was discussed, 12th December will be the date.

Lunch at Beechworth Bakery, 10 attended.

Gordon and Ian will be giving their talk / demonstrations to Damascus students on 29th/30th of October, would like a couple of additional helpers.

John Hazeldine VK3CFH and Gordon were participating in WICEN exercise on 8th October.

John Kennedy VK3AIG needs an assistant on the Red Cross emergency team if anyone is interested.

There has been nothing more heard regarding the Airport user groups EXPO which had been proposed For mid- November

David VK3BUR reported that the Light Car Club had been told that their lease would not be renewed as their building will be required for another purpose.

There was some discussion regarding the success or otherwise of the Shepparton and Albury Hamventions, Shepparton only had around thirty tables, and Albury around eight, one of the reasons for our success is the way that we help the traders set up and pack away their stands, this fact has been commented on by several of the traders.

Craig mentioned that the club tables for the Hamvention were open for donations of goods for sale, Bob had been contacted by Harold Benson VK3VSX regarding selling some equipment on consignment.

It was decided to have an informal dinner the night before Hamvention, David and Ian agreed to send e-mails to traders and others advising them of this.

Clem suggested that a contact board at Hamvention would be a good idea for those wanting to contact or be contacted by other attendees on the day, Ian and Roger will discuss and implement something.
