# Presidents Report

As we approach the end of the financial year we must also think about the need to elect the clubs committee of management for the coming year.

All positions become vacant although some members are available for another year. Here is the opportunity to either volunteer yourself or nominate someone else who you believe can fulfill a roll in the management of the club.

There also the non elected positions which we have had some vacancies with for the past year. Refer to Item eight in the formal notice.

Nomination forms need to be in hand of the Sec Doug VK3FDRE not less than seven days before the meeting which is the 29<sup>th</sup> July.

For the October meeting we will have Drew Diamond attending and giving a talk about the 136Khz and 500Khz band and showing some home made gear for the same. Drew is an active home brewer and has published four volumes of projects and will have some interesting gear to show and answer questions about. Please mark the diary.

The committee has decided to run a Field day activity soon to encourage club members to "go out portable" somewhere and activate and shake cobwebs from the gear. This will allow people to try out the project Squid pole antennas and other antennas. This will only be a few hours and we are considering then return to the clubrooms for food and fellowship afterwards. We would appreciate feedback and encouragement for the idea as we haven't done this for some years. Obviously need to do so in warmer months.

We have had a request for some more CTCSS tone boards for older sets so they can access the clubs repeater on Green Hill. Who else is interested. Please advise and we can produce at the construction night which has waned a bit lately. Second Monday each month.

It has been asked that we should consider having a 2M net one evening through the repeater VK3RBT. This will mean the need to access with the sub audible tone. Consider what night would suit and let the committee know. The 80M net still continues to run on a Thursday evening at 2000hrs on 3608Khz +/- QRM and the 2M net will not run concurrently in an effort to encourage more activity on the repeater and for those who do not get out on HF very well.

Please look at the BARG web site calendar and mark your diary up for the dates listed.. We had eleven members at the last "Coffee on Club" which is good to see. Next week {the 23<sup>rd</sup>} will be Coffee at Beechworth bakery. Hope see people then.

Finally on Dstar. It has been decided that we do no further work with the system at this stage due to a number of factors: (1) Our internet service is at maximum capacity with

the wireless system and any further demand on it would mean the remote base and IRLP service would suffer severe if not total degradation. (2) If the system were set up at the rooms the coverage of the 70/23cm would be very limited due to the topography. (3) Green Hill doesn't have internet connection so its not viable using that site either. (4) W e need to purchase a new antenna, cavity filters and coaxial cable to be able to set it up at any location.

The equipment is currently in storage.

### **Subscriptions Due.**

## Safety Message - Stop! Take 5

This is one example of a method of minimizing the risk of injury or damage to people or equipment that is widely used within industry, but it is every bit as applicable to tasks that we perform around the home (or shack).

1. Think through the task - Have a clear plan in mind, but be prepared to review it.

- Understand the task
- Procedure to follow
- Right tools and equipment
- People or equipment affected
- Safe access
- Nearby equipment
- What could go wrong
- Alternative methods

#### 2. Spot the hazards - Look Close, Look Wide, Look Above

For each step, consider:

- Can I be struck by anything?
- Can I strike against anything?
- Can It be caught in, or between anything?
- Can I strain or overexert?
- Can I slip or trip on anything?
- Can I fall in any way?
- Can I come in contact with or be exposed to anything harmful, such as chemicals, heat or fumes?
- Can I injure a fellow worker?
- Can damage to equipment occur?

#### 3. Assess the risks

- Is it improbable?
- Possible?
- Likely?
- What are the consequences?
- Injury or death?
- Property damage?

#### 4. Make the changes – control the risk.

- Remove the hazard
- Isolate the hazard
- Barricade the hazard
- Adopt a different approach, different tools or different method.

#### 5. Do the job safely

• If at any time you feel uneasy, step back and rethink what you are about to do.
