the BARG Internet Remote Base.

To be able to use the Remote Base, you must have an **User ID** and **Password**. The Password can be obtained from Bob,VK3BNC, Harry, VK3KGL and Bob, VK3NBV

Note: ID and Password are NOT case sensitive and may be entered in either upper or lower case. Do not share your account details with anyone else.

RULES FOR OPERATING THE BARG INTERNET REMOTE BASE:

All amateur radio operators using the VK3BML transmitter must abide by the following.

- 1. Voice: Identify in the following manner "Using the VK3BML Remote Base, this is VK3??? ".
- 2. You are only authorised to transmit in band segments that overlap your own licence privileges.
- 3. This system is limited to use by financial members of the Ballarat Amateur Radio Group (BARG).

Breaches from the above procedures will result in access to the system being immediately cancelled. Please make sure you tune the antenna on HF, by pressing the "ANT Tuner" button before transmitting.

INSTALLING / CONFIGURING THE SOFTWARE:

Download and install the latest version of "Web Transceiver" from www.w4mq.com/download.html

Start the program and select "Setup" / "Enter Logon Info" Click on a blank label under "Your Label" and enter "VK3BML" and click on this entry. On the right hand side it should prompt "Data for label = VK3BML" Enter in the following boxes: IRB Station: VK3BML IP/URL: barg.org.au USERCALL: VK3???? PASSWD:****** Press "SAVE" and "CLOSE"

From the "Setup" menu select "Select Sound Type" Select SkyPe. You may need to experiment here to get the best audio for your system. If you are using Skype (<u>www.skype.com</u>) for audio, the Skype Name to enter is: vk3bml_remotebase.

You should (hopefully) now be ready to select VK3BML from the drop down menu. If things have been configured then the box could be in one of a few states: Yellow – VK3BML is Available

Red - In use by callsign on XXXXX kHz

If Web Transceiver has not been configured correctly, or if the system is offline, then you may see the following message: Red - VK3BML in not On-line

Ian had also heard that there may be some person, or persons deliberately causing interference on the Ben Nevis repeater, and asked members to log any suspicious activity that they heard.

Gordon VK3FGC reported that he attends various emergency communications meetings, he feels that where we share sites with Government agencies we are likely to be charged site access fees in the future. There is no indication as to how much these might be.

The position regarding Public Liability insurance at these sites is unknown, and we will need to check our policy and consult with the WIA.

Doug VK3VBA commented that the Maryborough club had the use of the WIA100 callsign on the 3^{rd} - 5^{th} of August, should any members want to work them.

Access code on door has been changed, financial members should talk to Doug VK3VBA to request the new code.

Ernie VK3DET reported that there is a firewatch tower in the bush near Smythesdale which may be a suitable site for a repeater.

Ernie VK3DET, and Steve VK3SE net on 29.2MHz FM at 1930 on a Tuesday night and most other nights, any new attendees will be welcome.

Ernie VK3DET is looking for a "Stationmaster" antenna, if anyone has an unused one lying around.
