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6 Metres and Above

Another month has passed and those elusive higher frequency contacts have not been happening as often as in past years. Some good openings have been had on 2m VHF SSB into Western Australia with Stations VK3VOX, VK6LD, VK6WG and possibly some others being worked at good signal levels. Known active stations from the club have been VK3AIG, VK3PMG, VK3KG, VK3AXH and VK3WN who is mainly just monitoring. If I've missed

any others please let me know.

The Albany 2m beacon can often be heard but as there is a 3 hour time difference it can be difficult to get the VK6's up in the mornings for those qso's before they head off to work. Some activity can and does take place at night time as well.



This year the propagation seemed to have favoured our district better than in the past. In previous years the boys in Mt Gambier have often been favoured but overall it's been our area that's done very well.

Regular activity in the mornings around 144.1 take place and is quite active in Western Victoria and Adelaide with Gordon at Cobram also being a regular. Some aircraft enhanced propagation also takes place with Canberra on 144.2 SSB.

6 Metres has also been active with both John VK3AIG and Kevin VK3WN reporting some good propagation and contacts around VK and ZL. John has been active using WSPR with some success as well.

On some of the higher bands VK3AXH has had many qso's into Mt Gambier up to 1296MHz and 2 very good qso's with Colin VK5DK on 2.4G with signals over S9 on each occasion with distances of 274Km.

part in a 3.4GHz activity
from Mt Buninyong
between 10am to 12
Noon to see how many
other like stations could
be contacted using some
modified WiFi panels
kindly made available
through the Geelong
Amateur Radio Club. A

similar activity took place in NSW and QLD.

Over the period contacts were had with around 15 different stations located at various places around Geelong such as Mt Anakie, YouYangs, Port Arlington, Barrabool Hills, Lara as well as Mt Leura near Camperdown and Mt Dandenong a distance of around 135Km which is quite good given the power was less than 1 watt with 18dB patch antenna gain.

You can see one of the panels in the images below. At present we have around 7 local amateurs either completed or still working on their systems.

If anyone is interested in this project some panels are still available at \$25 each and a couple of small home brew pcb's are required with around



\$20 of components to get them going. They are driven by a UHF transceiver requiring around 2.5Watts and can be used on either SSB or FM. Please contact VK3AXH for further information.

State of Electronics – Video Series

A series of professional quality videos about the development of electronics in Australia, with interviews with well known names, such as Dick Smith and Leo Simpson. And some more recent high profile names, like Dave Jones from EEEBlog and Jonathan Oxer from Freetronics.

This is the story of the "State of Electronics", a documentary about the art and science of electronics and how it coincided with the modern formation of our society. Electronics starts out as digital in telegraphy in what has been dubbed the "Victorian Internet". It then changes state to analogue with advent of the valve and Lee De Forest's "triode", becoming Radio … later Television. Transistors change it's form in the 50's and 60's into "solid state". Integrated

circuits herald another change with the miniaturisation of hardware and the "space race" in the late 60's and 70's. The advent of electronic calculators, computers and micro controllers bring about the true digital age, with computational and computer programming changing the "state of electronics" into both hardware and software. The internet is born, forever changing what electronics means to most.
