## VHF UHF Field Day

### Great opportunities to head for the hills!

On Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> November three club members ventured onto Green Hill at the back of the Ballarat University to take part in the 8 hour multi section of the 24 hour VHF/UHF Field Day event.

Using John's callsign VK3AIG together with Ian's VK3IDL and VK3AXH operation was setup on 50MHz, 144MHz, 432MHz, 1296MHz and 2403Mhz using modest antenna's and power.

Max power for the day was on 50Mhz at 100 watts into a 4 element modified TV antenna whilst 50 watts was used on both 144 and 432 with 8 element and 14 element yagi's. On 1296 a 26 element was used and fed with home brew equipment with about 20 watts and 2403 using a grid pack antenna fed with home brew equipment with 10 watts.

Although contacts were not as high as in past events there was a good mix across all bands used particularly with Ian VK3IDL's 2403 MHz with contacts made to Kallista in the Dandenong Ranges and both Colin VK3DK and Trevor VK5MC both in Mount Gambier. On this band several contacts were made with the GARC located in the Barrabool Hills near Geelong.

As the afternoon progressed the wind got stronger and colder so it was decided not to stay for the full 8 hours. Let's hope the weather is kinder for the Summer Field in mid January.

If you are looking for some fun for a few hours why not get organized for the January event. If you have a simple antenna and only one band you can still have a lot of fun. Alternatively get a group together and have a go.
