15 Metres DL6, EA8, EW2, JA, OK1, UA1 and VR2 17 Metres Big pileup of signals from everywhere

20 Metres EA8, JA3, SV6 and VK

40 Metres Wall to wall signals from many counties

Most of Steve's contacts have been SSB but with reports of CW and SSTV as well.
