

BARG HF FIELD DAY ACTIVITY.

SUNDAY 11 APRIL 2021.

Following along from our last activity here is a chance for club members and anyone else to "go bush" for a while on a Sunday and try and work as many other BARG members as possible within a four hour period.

OUR AIM IS TO ENCOURAGE MEMBERS TO COME OUT FOR A SHORT TIME AND PUT A STATION UP IN THE FIELD AND LEARN FROM THE ACTIVITY HOW EASY IT CAN BE AND WHAT IS INVOLVED IN DOING SO WHILE ENJOYING THE EXPERIENCE.

Scoring is simple but for encouragement every field station may claim an extra two points for EVERY contact they make from their field position so its well worth going out.

MODE. Voice modes only. .

TIME. 1200 – 1600 EAST. Sunday 11 April 2021

BAND. 40M 7000-7300kHz. And 80M 3500-3700kHz.

Repeaters not allowed for scoring purposes.

Primary aim is to work club member to member to encourage other members but other stations on the bands may be worked also to accumulate points. Home based club members should announce they are operating from home and not in the field.

To assist scoring stations may work every 30 min period

SCORING:

5points for every club member worked. In field or at home.

Score 1point for every VK3 station worked.

Score 2 p per VK1/2/5//7 non club member.

Score 3 points per VK4/6 non member

Score 1 point per DX contact. Ie a non VK callsign

Score 6 points if working VK3BML the club station if activated.

As this is meant to be a club day activation for field stations to enjoy you may work stations a second an third time provided a 30min time has elapsed on that band. Another contact may be allowed on the second HF band if the 30min rule is observed there..

Logs should indicate the stations location clearly as field or home station and how about take a photo shot for inclusion in the newsletter when scores are submitted. Logs should be submitted to me by hand or last date of Friday 30 Apr at BARG club meeting.

Suitable log sheets are available on the clubs web site. Attach a cover sheet with station details, location, equipment used and antenna noting the power level.
