

BARG Field Day 11th October 2026

It is about time the BARG had another Field Day, so let's get the lead out and get going 😊

AIM:

- provide an opportunity to put some of the learnings from the 3 Information Sharing Sessions into practice,
- encourage members to go out for a short while *"into the field"* whilst enjoying the experience of *"getting back to radio"*
- try and work as many stations as possible within a 3 hour period.

Suggested CQ call is "CQ BARG FIELD DAY",

Scoring is simple: see below it's well worth going out.

Who Can participate: open to all qualified amateurs.

Back to basics: Paper logging. indicate the stations location clearly as field or home station Logs should be submitted on or before 31st October. Originals can be hand delivered. Scans or photos of your paper logs can be emailed to barg@barg.org.au

Suitable log sheets are available on the club's web site, Look under "What's on" -> "Field day"

Rules, let us keep it simple.

The Rules:		
Two bands	40M above 7063KHz, LSB (avoid FT8 on 7074KHzUSB)	2M SSB 144.150MHz +50KHz
Scoring per contact:	Home station: 1pt per contact	
	Portable station 2 pts per contact.	
	Repeat contacts allowed every ½ Hour.	
Timing:	0100 UTC to 0400 UTC on the 11 th of October 2026	This will give you a whole week after daylight savings start to acclimatize.
Logging:	Standard Logging required	Date, Time, RS(TX/RX)
Logs:	Paper Logs only.	Must be legible and submitted on or before 31 st October
Results:	Logs will be reviewed by Colin NCC and Peter APW	Judge's decision will be final, results will be available at the November General Meeting. Be there, or be Square!
